Fel eich bod efallai'n gwybod, ymgynghorodd Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Rhondda Cynon Taf yn ddiweddar ar gynigion i gyflwyno nodweddion arafu traffig a Therfyn Cyflymder 20mya yn Tylagarw, Pont-y-clun, Llanhari.

Cafodd manylion y cynllun diogelwch ar y ffyrdd arfaethedig eu dosbarthu â llaw a rhoddwyd cyfle i'r preswylwyr wneud sylwadau. Derbyniodd y Cyngor gyfanswm o 24 ymateb (roedd 19 o blaid a 5 yn erbyn y cynllun).


Yn dilyn sylwadau a gafodd eu derbyn yn ystod yr ymgynghoriad anffurfiol, mae dau o'r mesurau wedi'u hadleoli i safle y tu allan i'r eiddo o'r enw Cartref a Shiralee. Yn ogystal, mae marciau ffordd atodol i'w darparu ar y porth gorllewinol i dynnu sylw ymhellach at newid yn y terfyn cyflymder o 40 i 20mya.

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME AND REDUCTION OF THE EXISTING SPEED LIMITS IN TYLAGARW, PONTYCLUN, LLANHARRY.

As you may be aware, Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council (RCTCBC) recently consulted on proposals to introduce traffic calming features and a 20mph Speed Limit in Tylagarw, Pontyclun, Llanharry.

Details of the proposed road safety scheme were hand delivered and residents provided with the opportunity to comment. RCTCBC received 24 responses altogether (with 19 being generally in support and 5 objections).

Following comments received during the informal consultation, two of the features have been relocated to a position outside the properties known as Cartref and Shiralee. In addition, supplementary road markings are to be provided on the western gateway to further highlight a change in speed limit from 40 to 20mph.


Details of the proposed road safety scheme are shown on the attached drawings T2018/77/1 and 2. You may also wish to view the proposals at www.rctcbc.gov.uk/traffic

To provide further clarification, the proposed traffic calming features are full width round top road humps (with a 200mm channel either to allow for groundwater drainage).

The next stage in the process is a period of Public Notice of the proposals, where details of the scheme are advertised to provide opportunity for members of the public to formally raise any concerns they may have. If you wish to object to the proposals, you should do so in writing by 15th November 2019 to the Traffic Manager, Traffic Management, Sardis House, Sardis Road, Pontypridd, CF37 1DU or alternatively by email at trafficservices@rctcbc.gov.uk
