As you will be aware, during the construction of the Mountain Ash Cross Valley Link, waiting restrictions were temporarily introduced in Glyngwyn Street to assist with traffic flow.

Now that the works are substantially complete, residents are being asked whether they would like the restrictions to remain or alternatively have them removed.
