DATGANIAD O'R RHESYMAU

Mae trigolion lleol wedi mynegi eu pryder am barcio rhwystrol mewn lleoliadau amrywiol o amgylch Abercynon. Mae'r parcio yma'n achosi perygl i ddefnyddwyr eraill y ffordd ac yn effeithio ar lif y traffig. Y lleoliadau yw'r Ffordd Ddi-enw rhwng Heol Newydd a Heol Abercynon, Heol y Blanhigfa, Ffordd Aberpennar hyd at ei chyffordd â Heol y Blanhigfa, a Heol Aberdâr a'i chyffordd â Stryd y Pac, Llys Tŷ'r Twyn a Stryd Nash. Mae parcio'n agos at y cyffordd yn cyfyngu gwelededd ac yn effeithio ar lif traffig.

Er mwyn mynd i'r afael â'r pryderon, mae'r Cyngor wedi datblygu cynigion i gyflwyno Cyfyngiadau Gwahardd Aros ar Unrhyw Adeg yn y lleoliadau uchod.

Mae'r mesurau yma wedi'u cynnig dan Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig 1984 er mwyn hwyluso tramwy cerbydau, atal perygl tebygol a gwella diogelwch ar gyfer holl ddefnyddwyr y briffordd.

(REVOCATION AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2021

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Longstanding concerns have been raised by local residents that obstructive parking in various locations in Abercynon presents a danger to other road users and impacts on traffic flow. The locations are the Unnamed Road between New Road and Abercynon Road, Plantation Road, Mountain Ash Road at its junction with Plantation Road, and Aberdare Road at its junctions with Park Street, Llys Ty'r Twyn and Nash Street. Parking in the vicinity of the junctions restricts visibility and impacts traffic flow.

To address these concerns, proposals have been developed to introduce Prohibition of Waiting at Any time restrictions at the above locations.

These measures are proposed under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to facilitate the passage of traffic, prevent the likelihood of danger and to improve safety for all highway users.
