Introduction

A Statement of Modifications was published by public notice on 28th February 2014, and is the subject of a six week consultation (including consulting all those consulted originally in relation to the Draft Charging Schedule) between 28th February and 10th April 2014. The Statement of Modifications is submitted in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended).
