Please observe the following Terms & Conditions

- On arrival all caravans must register at the Reception Desk in the Inheritance Centre which is open: (9am – 4pm Mon-Fri)
 Any visitors arriving outside these times must telephone in advance so that special arrangements can be made. Full contact details must be given.
 All bookings must be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 or over.
- 2. All caravans, motor homes and trailer tents must be of proprietary manufacture and in good condition.
- 3. Payment for pitches should be made in advance. A pitch number will be allocated/shower block codes issued on booking.
- 4. Caravans, motor homes and trailer tents must park on the allocated pitch number.
- 5. No caravans, motor homes or trailer tents are to be pitched on the grassed area between the main entrance road and the "Grasscrete" caravan pitches, or on the grassed area adjacent to the toilets/showers block. No other structures are allowed on the caravan pitch site, this includes temporary storage units or sheds or other tents etc.
- 6. All caravans must remain on the pitch allocated unless requested to move by the manager.
- 7. All rubbish must be placed in the bins provided and the pitches must be kept clean and tidy at all times
- 8. Dogs are welcome at the Country Park. Owners are requested to keep their dogs under strict control at all times during their stay. Dog fouling must be cleaned up by the owner (dog bags are available from reception). No dog kennels can be placed on site.
- 9. The maximum period any person can stay on the site is two weeks per visit (provided it is paid in advance), with no return for two weeks and total maximum stay of six weeks a year. A maximum of 4 visits are allowed per year and one payment = one visit. Any extensions to these times must be approved by the manager or assistant
- 10. No trucks or commercial vehicles to be parked on site. Only one vehicle per caravan is allowed. Other vehicles must be parked in the visitors' carpark.

- 11. Parents/guardians are responsible for the children in their care.
- 12. Ball games, cycling, skateboarding and roller skating is prohibited on the caravan site.
- 13. Barbeques are allowed, provided suitable, safe equipment is used alongside a B.S.I. (or similar) approved fire extinguisher. Open fires and constructed hearths are not permitted. Guests must avoid scorching the grass and picnic tables. Ashes must be disposed of with care when cooled.
- 14. Barbeques, parties, music and social gatherings must end at 11pm.
- 15. Guests or pets shall cause no nuisance to any other user of the site.
- 16. Toilets and showers are for the use of caravanners only. Please close the doors after use to keep them secure.

Children must be accompanied by an adult when using the toilet and shower facilities.

- 17. The washbasins in the toilet areas are for face and hand washing only. Dedicated laundry and dish washing facilities are in the main foyer area and outside to the right of the main door.
- 18. No washing line other than clothes driers suspended from a caravan window is allowed. A washing machine and drier are available in the foyer. Tokens are £3 each and can be purchased at the Reception Desk in the Inheritance Centre.
- 19. A 10mph speed limit around the site must be observed at all times.
- 20...The right is reserved to refuse access to the park to any person or persons without giving reason.
