Preparing a flood kit of essential items is a key way of minimising the risks and impacts of flooding, if you choose to stay in your home or are evacuated to a rest centre.

Discuss as a household what you would like to pack in a flood kit. There are suggestions below and you can add anything extra you need.

	Copy of your flood plan

	A phone charger and portable battery pack
	Torch with spare batteries; a wind-up torch is a good backup
	A radio – on your phone or battery operated
	Baby food and baby care items
	A first aid kit and prescription medication
	Bottled water (check use-by date) and non-perishable food
	Warm, waterproof clothing and blankets
	Rubber gloves and wellington boots
