Dangerous Tree Questionnaire

In order for an Officer to consider whether a tree is in such a condition that it is likely to cause damage to persons or property the following information needs to be gathered. If you cannot provide all the required information, the Public Health and Protection Department will not be able to action your complaint and you will be requested to provide additional evidence.

2. Address and map detailing the location of the tree	
3. Land ownership details (please attach a copy of the Land Registry record) https://www.gov.uk/search-property-information-land-registry	
4. Details of action taken to resolve the matter with the land owner. Including copies of letters/correspondence requesting action.	
5. Type of tree	
6. Approximate height of tree	
7. A copy of the professional arborist report or signed letter from arborist confirming tree is in a dangerous condition.	

8. Details of attached photographs.	
9. Is the condition of the tree likely to be a danger to persons? If yes, please outline how?	
10. Is the tree likely to cause structural damage to property? If yes, what will be affected?
