#### Agreed –

- To approve housing and health action areas as the delivery mechanism for the objective relating to housing and community regeneration contained in the Single Integrated Plan.
- To support the areas identified in the report as the ones that will be the focus for the Housing and Health Action Areas as part of an agreed programme of housing improvements and health interventions over the next three to five years.
- That the Council's Housing Strategy and Standards Team will provide the project management for the Housing and Health Action areas through agreed action plans and that these will be delivered in partnership with key stakeholders such as the Local Health Board, Housing Associations, Private Landlords and other external organisations depending on the action required.
- To support the recommended approach of undertaking stock condition surveys, utilising existing Council resources in the identified areas to establish a baseline and identify housing improvements required which will form the basis for the individual area action plans.

**Note:** With the permission of the Chairman, County Borough Councillor P.Jarman spoke on this item and indicated that she had no problem with the concept or the way the areas were determined. She also queried the role of Cwm Taf Local Health Board in assisting the Council in its approach.
