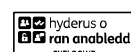

### **Wind Street Bond Street - Proposed Parking Review 2019**

As you may be aware, the Council consulted on proposals to introduce waiting restrictions (yellow lines) in Wind Street and Bond Street Aberdare. 2 responses were received from Wind Street regarding residents parking and traffic calming which are outside the remit of this proposal and 4 responses were received from Bond Street objecting to yellow lines however, those objections have been considered and rejected on the grounds of road safety.

Residents may still be able to park overnight as long as they do not cause an obstruction. Other suggestions from Bond Street for additional Waiting Restrictions may not be necessary at this time.

The next stage is a period of Public Notice of the proposals, where details of the scheme are advertised to provide opportunity for members of the public to formally raise any comments they may have.
