

RHONDDA CYNON TAFF COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

(LLANTRISANT ROAD, GRAIG, PONTYPRIDD)

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2022

Whereas the Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the Highway Authority for Llantrisant Road, Graig, Pontypridd are satisfied that traffic should be restricted in order for works to be carried out on or near the road to facilitate carriageway resurfacing

Now therefore the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers in that behalf hereby make the following order: -

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Llantrisant Road, from its junction with Maendy Road to its junction with Dan-Y-Coedcae Road

The alternative route for vehicles will be; from the southern side of the closure, proceed via Llantrisant Road, Penycoedcae Road, Gwaunmiskin Road, B4595 Llantrisant Road, A473 Church Village Bypass, Tonteg Road, Upper Boat Roundabout, A470, Broadway, Sardis Road, Factory Lane and Llantrisant Road to the northern side of the closure.

For vehicles travelling in the opposite direction, reverse the directions given above.

Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles

Access **WILL NOT** be maintained for pedestrians

The closure is expected to be in operation during the following dates, or until such time as the works have been completed:-

- Daytime closure 8:00am – 6:00pm between 25th – 29th April 2022

This Order will have a maximum duration of eighteen months and may be cited as the “Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council (Llantrisant Road, Graig, Pontypridd) (Temporary Road Closure) Order, 2022”.
