Following the planning permission for a new residential development on land in Grover Street, the Council has developed proposals to provide double yellow lines on the junction with Birdsfield Cottages. This is to allow the junction to be used as a turning area for vehicles in Grover Street. The proposed restrictions are required in the interest of highway safety.


In the previous informal consultation, several comments were received regarding Albert Road, and I can advise you that a review of the parking restrictions on Albert Road will be carried out this financial year, although I am unable to provide any details or timescales at the moment.

However, please note that this letter specifically refers to the proposed double yellow lines in Grover Street, and details of the proposals are shown on the attached drawing TM23/234/GA Rev-1, which may also be viewed at www.rctcbc.gov.uk/traffic

The next stage is a period of Public Notice of the proposals, where details of the scheme are advertised to provide opportunity for members of the public to formally raise any concerns they may have. If you wish to object to the proposals, you should do so in writing by **09/08/2024**, to the Traffic Services Manager, 2 Llys Cadwyn, Pontypridd CF37 4TH, or alternatively by email at trafficservices@rctcbc.gov.uk
