

# Case Study

## Ynyshir Primary – Young Ambassadors project

As a school Ynyshir already offered many after school clubs but they wanted to introduce something new for their pupils. Their Bronze Ambassadors completed a survey and gathered data to see what new club the children wanted to have in school. The pupil consultation showed demand for dodgeball, so a lunchtime club was introduced. There was also interest in dance so an afterschool club was established, delivered by Tip Top Dance.

The dance club quickly became the leading club for numbers participating each week. 25 children took part over the 10 weeks and the children performed their dance in front of their peers in assembly. The club was so popular that the school have decided to offer it again the following term.

The school now have a strong link with the local dance provider and some children from the school have joined local community sessions.

### Why they did it?

- To get more children involved in after school clubs
- To encourage more children to take part in physical activity
- To have increased levels of physical activity in school and the community
